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

- World from bipolar to unipolar (US, by Charles Krauthammer in 1990) to multipolar
- 2 main competitors for USA:
- European Union, taken as a whole, also seen as emerging global actor.
- BRIC => Brazil, India and China -- emerging global powers
  - => Russia resurging great power
- => South Africa (BRICS) strategic country
- \* China closest to USA power, not only economically, very active militarily

- ▶ 2010 BRIC + South Africa
- 2014 New Development Bank
- => I<sup>st</sup> new institution after establishment Bretton Woods institutions, IMF & World bank
- => change balance of powers

- West worrying about possibility







- => initial size US\$100 billion


to prevent short-term liquidity pressures and further strengthen financial stability





- China not amused
- India, US (1992, with suspension between 1998-2002) and Japan hold joint naval exercises
- 2015 Japan joins permanently US-India Naval Exercises
- already joined in 2007, 2009, 2014
- ➤ On other hand: maritime security cooperation between two Navies





- BRICS coastal states
- EEZ provide BRICS with enormous quantities of living and non-living resources
- BRICS countries highly dependent on seas and connected with each other through Atlantic, Pacific, Indian and Arctic Oceans
- common interests in Polar Regions i.e. Arctic and Antarctic
- Maritime security high on agenda of BRICS nations
- ► Maritime lanes
- **Piracy**
- Drugs trafficking



### BRICS COOPERATION IN SECURITY

- 9-7-2015, 7<sup>th</sup> Summit meeting in Ufá, Russia: Declaration
- 31. Piracy and armed robbery at sea represent significant threat to security of international navigation
- => "we intend to reinforce our cooperation towards this goal" [counteracting these types of criminal offences]
- 2008: Russia, India active in Gulf of Aden with others,
- End 2008: China PLAN joined anti-piracy activities


- BRICS countries prominent regional players in maintaining regional security
- All BRICS countries key UN members in maintaining international peace and security.
- BRICS: valuable contributions to UN peacekeeping operations by providing troops, training, and by voting for supportive mandates


- ▶ 2010 BRICs stated that



### MODERNISATION MILITARY EQUIPMENT, HUMAN RESOURCES

- Brazil: since 2005 investing heavily in modernisation military equipment
- Substantial increase in defence budget, technology transfer, develop national nuclear, cyber and space technologies, defence industry

- Russia aims to retain and improve its defence capabilities:
- greater investment, foreign technology transfer and the creation of a Russian version of the U.S. Defense
   Advanced Research Products Agency (DARPA)
- ➤ 2015: France suspends, delivering 2 Mistral to Russia and weapons to Ukraine

MODERNISATION MILITARY EQUIPMENT, HUMAN RESOURCES

- ▶2015 India's Military modernisation picks up pace
- ▶ 36 Rafale fighters,....
- +reforms considered crucial: equipment + HR
- ▶ 2015 China's White Paper
- Ambitious all-encompassing plans
- South Africa, most modest programme
- Strong accent on developing national industry



- BRICS: joint acquisition, development military equipment
- Mostly Russian project
- China, India buy Russian military equipment
- South Africa, Brazil interested
- development of production cooperation
- carrying out joint research and development projects (R&D)
- creation effective system of after-sale servicing
- ignition into markets of third countries,
- products released jointly in framework of agreements on licensed arms production



South Africa is interested in Russian helicopters

idea joint production + marketing RU, BR, SA

- 26-12-2014
- President Putin signed new military doctrine for Russian armed forces
- >=> document advocates development of military cooperation with other BRICS members.
- ▶ Why?
- Russia encircled by NATO
- China also encircled by Washington
- >=> more US naval activity in Pacific + US forces in Australia facing Beijing
- India targeted by NGO's funded by US and northern EU countries
- South Africa also targeted, by UK: incapable of maintaining law and order,...
- ▶ Brazil?



#### CONCLUSION

- BRICS became much more than concept
- only group capable of offsetting traditional powers, reshaping world
- traditional powers => losing space
- new ones => emerging, specially BRICS
- Putin: BRICS "whole set of coinciding strategic interests"
  - United command several stages away
